Introduces children to the English language from the age of 3 years old in the kindergarten.

Taught by qualified native English teachers in kindergarten and primary school.

English teachers speak only English with the students.

Early introduction to English letters and sounds, reading and writing.

Background of the Early Bird Project

The initiative of Prof.Dr. Carl Hahn in collaboration with the Antonius Holling Foundation.

Project launched in August 2007 at the Edith Stein Kindergarten.

First group consisted of 17 children and 1 Native Speaker.

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In the Eichendorffgrundschule

English available from the 1st class.

English taught between 6-15 hours per week bilingually or through immersion with Native English speaking teachers.
